



Cafeteria Point of Sale Debit System 2021-2022 School Year

Fairfield Public Schools

- Your school uses a computerized point of sale system in the cafeteria. Parents can make payments online.
- This system allows for account purchase of meals and snacks.
 - Parents may pay in advance for purchases.
- All students will be issued a Personal Identification Number (PIN) which corresponds to their food service account and which should be kept confidential.
- Any prepaid meals on a meal card from the previous year will automatically be put on the student's account.
 - Any remaining funds at the end of the school year are available for use in September or may be transferred to a sibling's account.

Online Payments

- Log on to payschoolscentral.com
- Select the "Register" option on the Welcome Page
- The screens will guide you through the process to establish your account
- The internet convenience fee is a percentage for credit cards and a flat fee for ACH transaction
