All the equipment belongs to the HSA and is maintained and replaced by the HSA. Technically Churchill needs a new freezer but since Stevenson has a big one (which is no longer needed now that 3rd grade is in Churchill) and Stevenson's freezer is in good shape, Maschio's suggested the HSA purchase a smaller freezer for Stevenson and move the one currently at Stevenson to Churchill. The approximate price for the 2 door freezer is \$7K and 3 door freezer is \$10K. We still need to look into electrical, etc. but we want to vote to approve the purchase of the new freezer.
